The product references – including ATP Tour events, Davis Cup Ties, the 12 outdoor and indoor acrylic courts at The National Tennis Centre in London together with courts at leading training centres around the world – support the tennis credentials and quality of this surfacing system.

The surface takes spin and slice and provides an extremely consistent, medium pace of play, ideal for developing an “all court” game. GreenSet® Acrylic surfaces are exceptionally hard wearing, require minimal maintenance and are very easy to ‘resurface’ when the time comes. A GRAND PRIX court may only require cleaning and re-coating to bring it back to almost new condition making it a sound and cost effective investment over its life span.

With the addition of ‘cushion’ layers the GRAND PRIX CUSHION surface provides a comfortable and more forgiving court for long periods of intensive play or coaching.

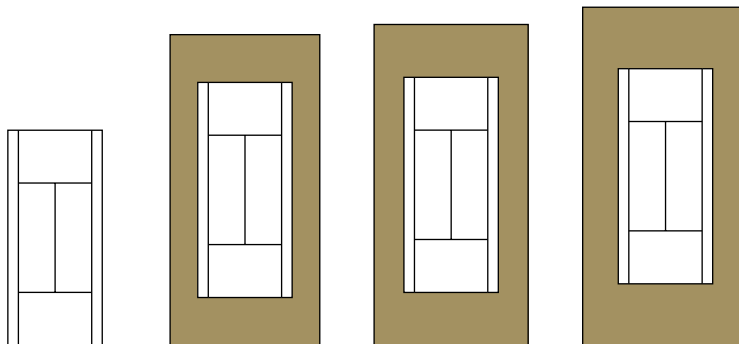


ITF Court Pace Classification
